CREDENTIAL TYPES AND SPECIFICATIONS

Global Christian Ministry Forum Canada offers three types of credentials. The type issued will depend on:

- a) the candidate's ministry qualifications as outlined below
- b) recommendations from references provided on the application form
- c) any additional recommendations and/or information GCMF Canada may seek
- d) personal and/or telephone interviews conducted by a GCMF Canada representative
- e) the final decision of GCMF Canada.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR EACH TYPE OF CREDENTIAL

Christian Worker:

The candidate must satisfy at least one (1) of the following criteria:

- a) be involved in a definable ministry above and beyond usual church volunteer activities
- b) be recognized by associates as a person showing ministerial calling and qualities

Licensed Minister:

The candidate must satisfy at least one (1) of the following criteria:

- a) must be recognized by ministry associates as a person showing one of the ministry gifts enumerated in Eph. 4: 11 (Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Pastor, Teacher)
- b) must be involved in a ministry that demands recognition as a clergy person
- c) must have a definable ministry position in an organized church

Ordination:

Candidates considered for ordination must have been licensed with GCMF Canada for a period of not less than one year or must have held ordination with another reputable, GCMF-recognized organization immediately prior to applying with GCMF Canada. **Holding a License with GCMF Canada for one year does not automatically qualify a candidate for ordination.** The candidate must also satisfy at least one (1) of the following criteria:

- a) must be engaged in a successful Apostolic, Prophetic, Evangelistic, Pastoral or Teaching ministry (Eph. 4: 11) that is recognized by peers and evidenced by followers
- b) must be employed by a ministry that requests the ordination of the candidate. (If the requesting ministry is controlled by the candidate they must also satisfy one other point.)
- c) must be engaged in professional ministry where ordination is an asset
- d) must be engaged in voluntary ministry where ordination is a legal requirement.

A person seeking ordination must obtain letters of endorsement from ministry associates that demonstrate qualification according to the above criteria. GCMF Canada may also seek additional pertinent information and letters of endorsement as they see fit. Ordination is awarded only after a thorough search of a person's references and the endorsement of others who know the results of their ministry. Those who are accepted will receive confirmation of their call by the laying on of hands. This can be done in a specified meeting or at a local church. Arrangements must be made with the District Coordinator or the GCMF Canada office, as required.
